BREWING QUALITY

A close descendant of Hallertau Mittelfruh bred for disease resistance and larger yields. Very refined, sweet aroma. Use for aroma and flavor additions in Lager, Pilsner, Bock, Wheat, Weizen.





ORIGIN / HISTORY

German origin. A close descendent of Hallertau Mittlefrüh, bred for disease resistance at the Hüll Hop Research Institute in Germany.

AGRONOMICS

Resistant to both Verticillium wilt and downy mildew.

ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids

3 - 7% w/w

Beta Acids

4 - 5% w/w

Cohumulone

26 - 29% of alpha acids

OIL COMPONENTS

Total Oil

1.0 - 1.4 mls/100 grams

Caryophyllene

10 - 15% of whole oil

Farnesene Humulene

<1% of whole oil

Myrcene

45 - 55% of whole oil

20 - 25% of whole oil
