#### **BREWING QUALITY**

Polish dual-purpose hop, daughter of Lubelski and Savinjsky Golding and a male Yogoslavian hop variety. This type was almost forgotten due to its unusual aroma profile, today it is a popular choise for Grätzer style beers.





## **ORIGIN / HISTORY**

Polish origin. Pedigree of Lubelski x Savinski Golding hybrid and Yugoslavian male.

### **AGRONOMICS**

Dual-purpose hop. Aromas of tropical and citrus fruits. All accompanied by short, clean bitterness.

#### **ACID COMPONENTS**

Alpha Acids 8 – 11% w/w Beta Acids 3.8% w/w

Co-Humulone 3.0% of alpha acids

Total Oil 1.3 ml/100 g

Myrcene 45.6% of whole oil Humulene 21.4% of whole oil Caryophyllene 8.7% of whole oil
