Torrefied at medium temperatures to avoid bitterness.

Usage:

Light, with few or no alcohol, White, Abbey or Trappiste type beers.
Recommended mixture : up to 20 %

Characteristics:

Cara 20 imparts a rich, caramel-sweet aroma and unique toffee-like flavour, adding golden to light amber colour to beer. A distinguishing characteristic of all Caramel malts is glassiness. This glassy endosperm creates the desirable non-fermentable components that give true Caramel Malt the ability to contribute mouth feel, foam, foam retention, and extended beer stability.

Storage & Shelf life:

Malt should be stored in a clean, cool (< 18 °C), dry (< 35 RH %) area. Under these conditions best if used all whole kernel products within 12 months from the date of manufacture and all milled products within 3 months.

Packaging:

Bulk; Bags (25kg, 50kg); Big Bags (400-1 200kg)
