Bobek

BREWING QUALITY

Dual purpose hop. Bobek has an intense and pleasant hoppy aroma. Beer prepared with this variety has good organoleptically scores for its bitterness and aroma.





ORIGIN / HISTORY

Slovenian origin. Bobek is a diploid hybrid between Northern Brewer and a TG seedling of unknown origin.

AGRONOMICS

Medium late variety. The rootstock is susceptible to downy mildew, the leaves are resistant and the cones slightly susceptible. It is grown on moderately deep and deep clay soil.

ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids 2-7% w/w Beta Acids 4-7% w/w

Co-Humulone 25-35% of alpha acids

Type T90 Hop Pellets



OIL COMPONENTS

Total Oil 0.7-4 ml/100 g

Myrcene 30-55% Humulene 12-19% Farnesene 3-8% Caryophyllene 4-6%

Linalool of total Oil 1-2% Linalool: Alpha-Acid 0.33-0.40 **Type Leaf Hops**



Possible substitutions: Fuggles, Willamette, Styrian Golding
