ADMIRAL

BREWING QUALITY

An excellent, high alpha-acid hop with balanced bitterness combined with an acceptable aroma profile; a versatile replacement for both high alpha and dual purpose varieties.



ORIGIN / HISTORY

UK origin. Bred at Wye College to complement Target. Released in the late nineties and still growing in acreage, it promises eventually to yield higher than Target.

AGRONOMICS

Resistant to downy mildew; susceptible to powdery mildew and to wilt.

ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids	13.5 – 16.2% w/w
Beta Acids	4.8 – 6.0% w/w
Cohumulone	37 - 45% of alpha acids

OIL COMPONENTS

Total Oil	1.0 – 1.7 mls/100 grams
Caryophyllene	6.8 – 7.2% of whole oil
Farnesene	1.8 – 2.2% of whole oil
Humulene	23 - 26% of whole oil
Myrcene	39 - 48% of whole oil
