# **CENTENNIAL**

## **BREWING QUALITY**

Dual purpose hop. Very balanced hop, sometimes called a super Cascade. Good in all US Ale styles, has been used with US Wheat beers.



# **ORIGIN / HISTORY**

Belgian origin. Selected from a cross between Brewer's Gold and a selected USDA male.

#### **AGRONOMICS**

Good, neat well hopped bines maturing mid-season. A medium sized dense compact cone. No visible reaction to infection with Prunus necrotic ring-spot virus. Moderately resistant to Verticillium Wilt.

## ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids7 – 12% w/wBeta Acids3.5 – 5% w/wCohumulone29 – 30% of alpha acids

## **OIL COMPONENTS**

Total Oil	0.8 – 2.3 mls/100 grams
Caryophyllene	5 – 8% of whole oil
Farnesene	<1% of whole oil
Humulene	10 - 20% of whole oil
Myrcene	45 - 60% of total oil
