### **BREWING QUALITY**

Polish dual-purpose hop, daughter of Lubelski and Savinjsky Golding and a male Yugoslavian hop variety. This type was almost forgotten due to its unusual aroma profile, today it is a popular choice for Grätzer style beers.



### **ORIGIN / HISTORY**

Polish origin. Pedigree of Lubelski x Savinski Golding hybrid and Yugoslavian male.

### **AGRONOMICS**

Dual-purpose hop. Aromas of tropical and citrus fruits. All accompanied by short, clean bitterness.

Alpha Acids 8 – 11% w/w  
Beta Acids 3.8% w/w  
Co-Humulone 3.0% of alpha acids
